

The Un-Fixie Fixed Cog Remover

The Un-Fixie wrench takes the place of the conventional chain whip cog remover tool.

First, assemble the pins into the correct holes. The circles engraved into the tool indicate the correct pin location for the large number engraved into the tool, 16, 17, 18 or 19. The triangles indicate the alternate pin location for 20 tooth cogs and the squares indicate the alternate location for 15 tooth cogs. Install the lockwashers under the screws and firmly tighten with an allen wrench.

To use the tool, install against the cog with the correct end, install the aluminum locking cup and secure with an axle nut.
